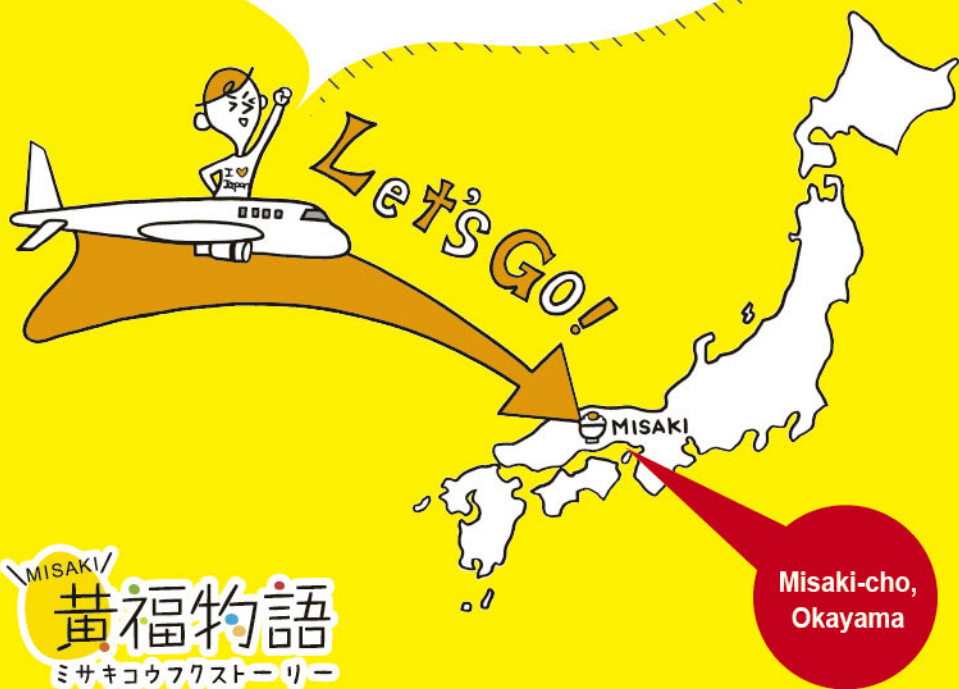

In Misaki Town, Okayama Prefecture,
we are famous for rice topped with raw egg called Tamago Kake Gohan and as the town of yellow and happiness.



Misaki's most recommended specialty, Tamago Kake Gohan, **TKG** (Tamago Kake Gohan)

Yellow is the color known to bring happiness. "Kofuku" is a word that combines yellow and happiness. In Misaki-cho, you get to experience the local specialty, Tamago Kake Gohan, food, scenery, and many more things that are yellow and symbolize happiness. Why not visit Misaki Town to find your yellow and happiness?



There are three types of soy sauce-based sauces: shiso leaves, seaweed, and green onions. Many customers say that these sauces make a trip to Misaki worthwhile.

What makes Misaki's eggs different is their freshness meaning they can be consumed raw!

The secret behind the deliciousness of Misaki Farm's Mori no Tamago is the exquisite blend of feed developed from years of research. The feed contains high-quality fish oil extracted from tuna and bonito, mugwort, and paprika. The egg has a rich taste because it was developed in pursuit of the natural deliciousness of eggs, such as their flavor, color, and shine. In addition, Mori no Tamago is a good source of DHA and vitamin E to promote health. After the eggs are laid, they are moved to the factory on a belt conveyer without coming in contact with hands. The eggs are then washed and checked for cracks prior to being packaged to ship to stores.



Safe and secured shipment lines are used to ship to stores! The lot alphabet letters shown on the package tell where the eggs came from. The letters for Misaki eggs are U and W.

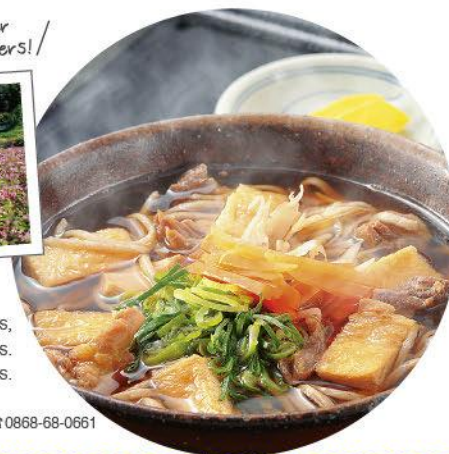
Hashino Shokudo 橋野食堂

A beautiful rural landscape selected as one of Japan's top 100 rice terraces (Ohaganishi)

The mortar-shaped rice terraces in Ohaganishi spread 360 degrees around the valley. There are 800 rice terraces in the curved landscape, creating a unique stripe pattern. Situated at an altitude of 400 m, the snow-covered terraces make this a popular destination. Visitors can also take in the beautiful scenery in all four seasons. Misaki's Tamago Kake Gohan is made using the rice grown in these rice terraces.

The park houses the Kichigahara Station of the defunct Katakami Railroad, where an old train runs on the first Sunday of every month! Enjoy the nostalgic atmosphere of old trains and mining experiences.

Miyasumi Park 三林公園

There are 5,000 cherry blossom trees and 10,000 azaleas that come into bloom in the season. Visitors can enjoy viewing the beautiful flowers while driving to the mountaintop. The park also offers a pottery workshop using a glaze made of cherry ashes.

Tsuyama Castle (Kakuzan Park) 津山城(備前公園)

Kakuzan Park is nestled on the ruins of an ancient castle, Tsuyama Castle, and has earned its name as one of Japan's top 100 cherry blossom sites. There are about 1,000 somei-yoshino cherry blossom trees that come into bloom in spring, creating breathtaking scenery reminiscent of a sea of clouds!
